

## Start your application

Your application can be made online by registering your details or logging in at:

[www.aerosociety.com/apply\\_now](http://www.aerosociety.com/apply_now)

Once you have updated all your details, click 'Apply Now' and choose the Fellow grade. The online form will ask you to upload the following details:

- CV showing detailed work history and contribution to the industry
- Evidence of qualifications (if applicable)
- 2 x referees (who are Fellows of the Society)
- Organisational chart (where you sit within your company)
- Details of any published papers (if applicable)

Once your application has been submitted, approved by your nominated referee and the administration fee paid (if applicable), your application will be reviewed by the Membership Committee at their next meeting.

**You will be informed of the result within two weeks of the respective Membership Committee meeting.**
